Grant us peace

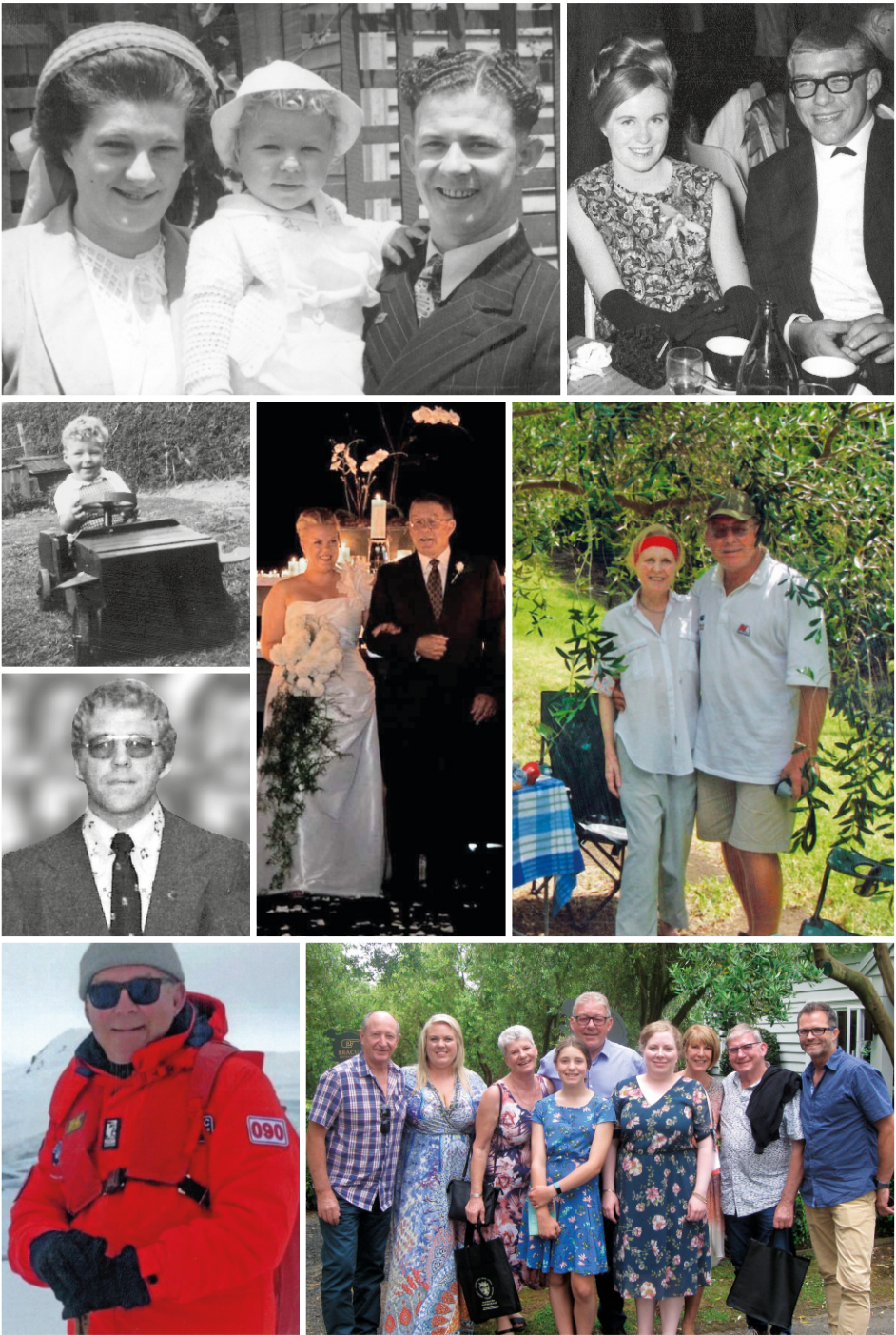
Fr Anthony: Behold the Lamb of God...
