and leave our seat empty

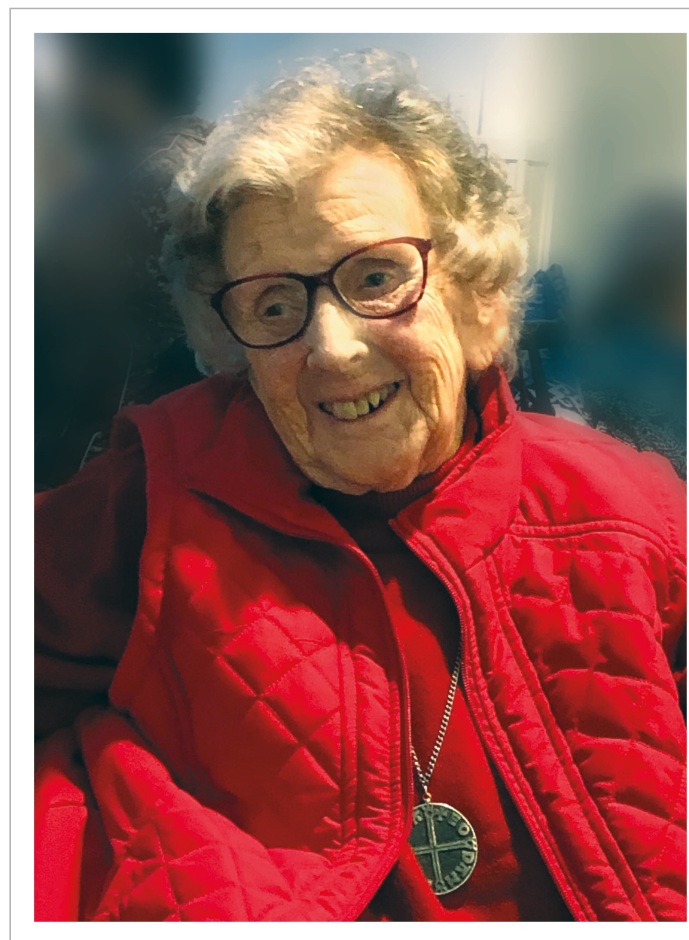
we should leave behind beautiful
